## Port Rowan Farmers' Market 2024

The mission of the Port Rowan Farmers' Market is to support local, organic, and sustainable agriculture and to build community by providing; an accessible and welcoming environment where local residents, cottagers, and tourists can purchase fresh, quality food and products directly from local farmers, producers and artisans.

Criteria for accepting vendors is simple: **Grow It, Make It, Bake It, Create It!** This is a producers market and we do not accept products that are re-sale of wholesale or mass manufactured goods. Priority will be given to vendors from the region. (See Rules and Regulations for more information about Priority).

## **General Guidelines**

- 1) The market will be open **3:00 pm till 6:00 pm Fridays** Jun 7<sup>th</sup> till Oct 11<sup>th</sup> at the Lions Pavilion in the Port Rowan Harbour. Set-up may be no earlier than 2pm and must be completed by 3pm. Please be set up on time. **No selling is permitted before 3 pm**.
- 2) It is an outdoor market. While we do our best to accommodate vendors' needs, it is likely that your products will be exposed to the elements. If this is a concern for your product, you are responsible for managing the situation either through canopy tents or shade cloths.
- 3) Vendors are responsible for making sure their canopies/tents/umbrellas are secured with tie downs/weights/stakes and tie-downs are flagged to prevent tripping. Electrical cords must all be marked and secured if they cross the path of foot traffic.
- 4) Vendors are responsible for keeping their immediate site clean and orderly, and removing all garbage. Tents, if used, must be fully secured at all times.
- 5) It is recommended that all vendors have their own insurance. The Port Rowan Farmers' Market has basic Public Liability and Property Damage through Farmers Market Ontario that does provide limited coverage for vendors. Commercial vendors with 'storefront' businesses and wineries are NOT covered by this insurance and are required to provide proof of their own insurance, with the Port Rowan Farmers' Market, The Officers & Directors of Farmers' Markets Ontario, and Norfolk County added as 'additional insured'. The Port Rowan Farmers' Market bears no responsibility for any vendor property at the market.
- 6) Where applicable (e.g. baking, preserves, ready-to-eat food), a certificate of inspection/communication with Haldimand Norfolk Health Unit is required.
- 7) Once a month we ask vendors to make a small donation of products (\$5-\$10 value) to our monthly Loyalty Program draw. Contributions are not mandatory, but appreciated to help encourage regular customers.
- 8) If you are unable to attend the Farmers' Market, please notify the committee as soon as possible, preferable a week in advance.
